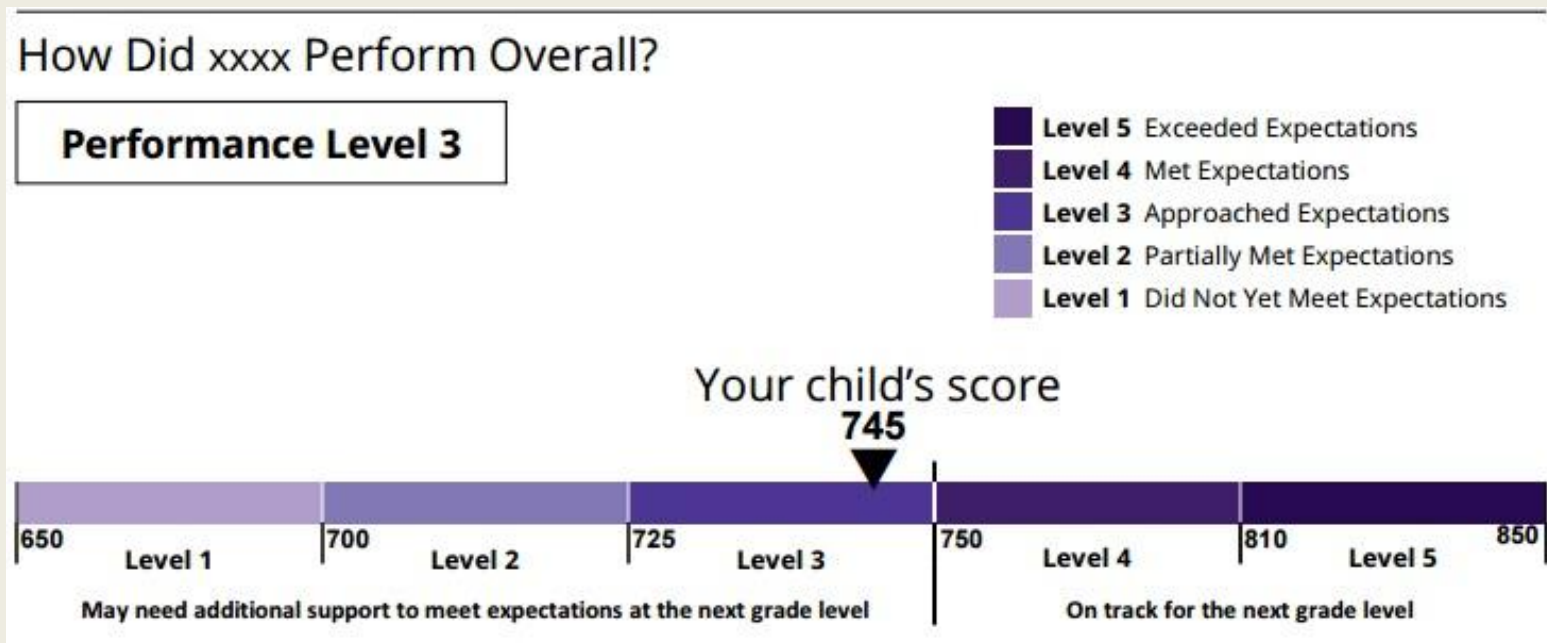

# NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- 2019 marked the 1st administration of the NJ-SLA test which replaced the PARCC assessment. Although new, it was still produced by Pearson and therefore continued to give us another opportunity to compare year-to-year results as the following slides will show.
- Students were required to take NJ-SLA English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 – 10 ( 11th grade was optional)
- Students took NJ-SLA Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 – 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II. Juniors were exempt as well last year.

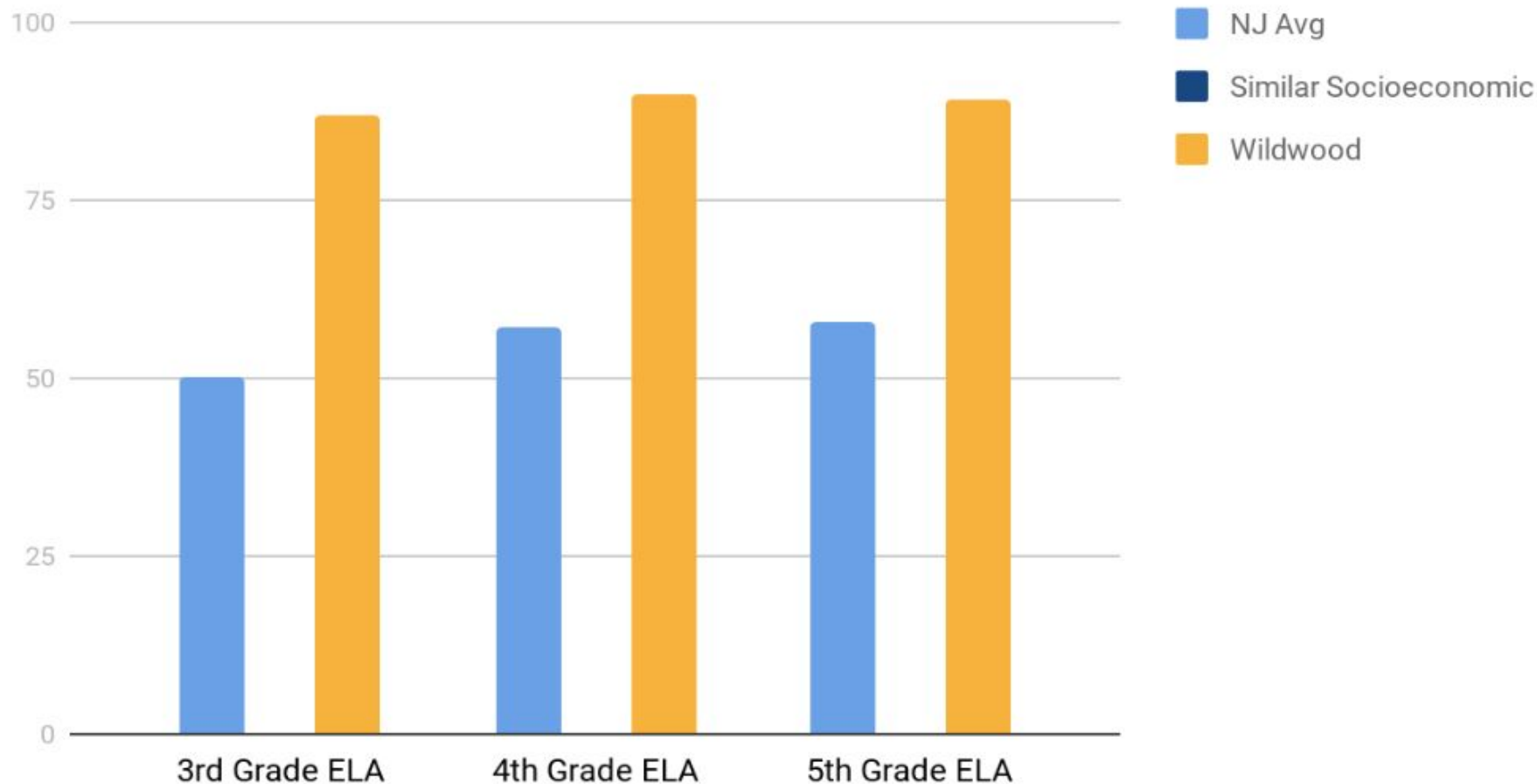

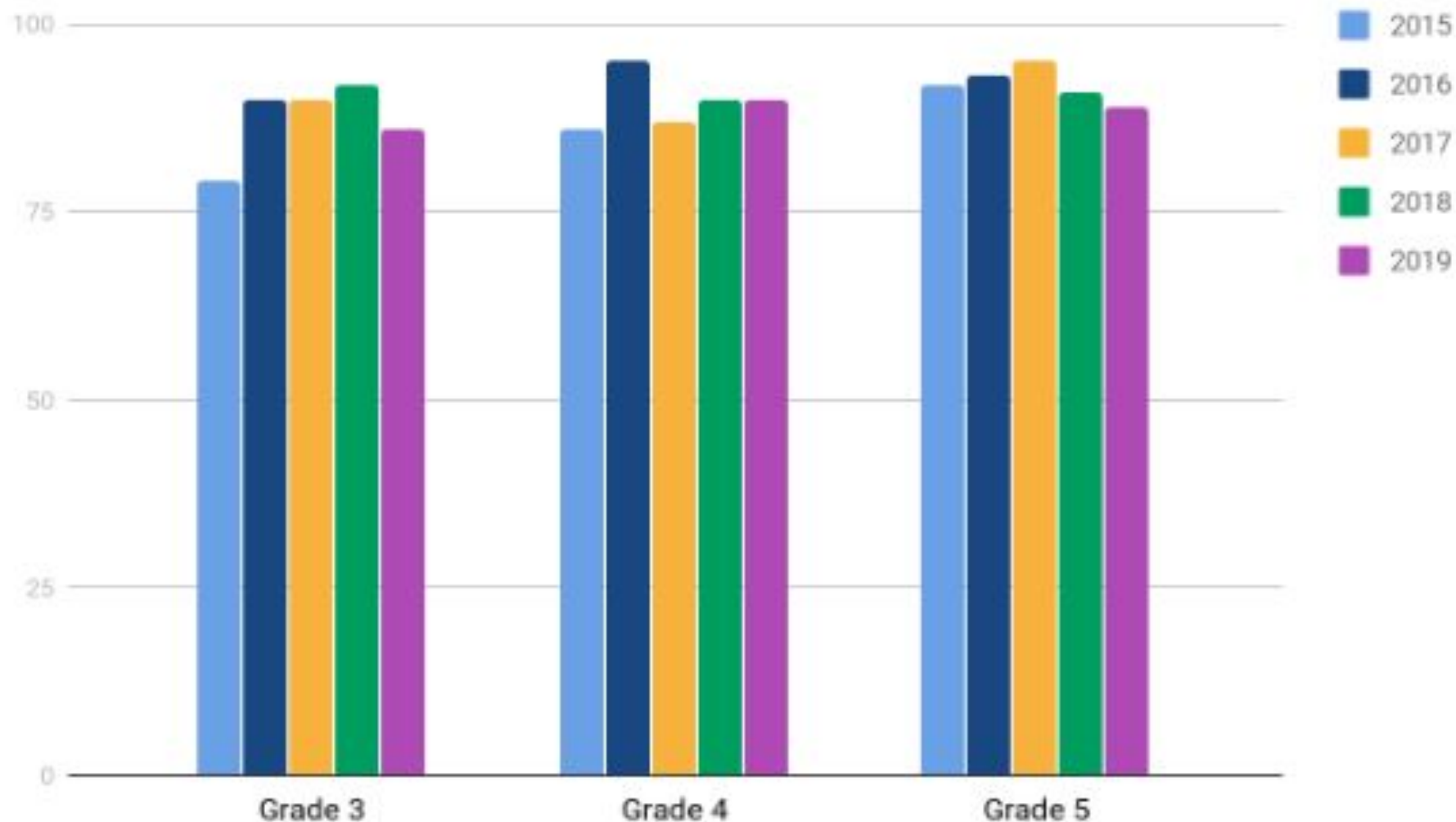


# WILDWOOD: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 3<sup>RD</sup>-5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE ELA 2019

% Passing

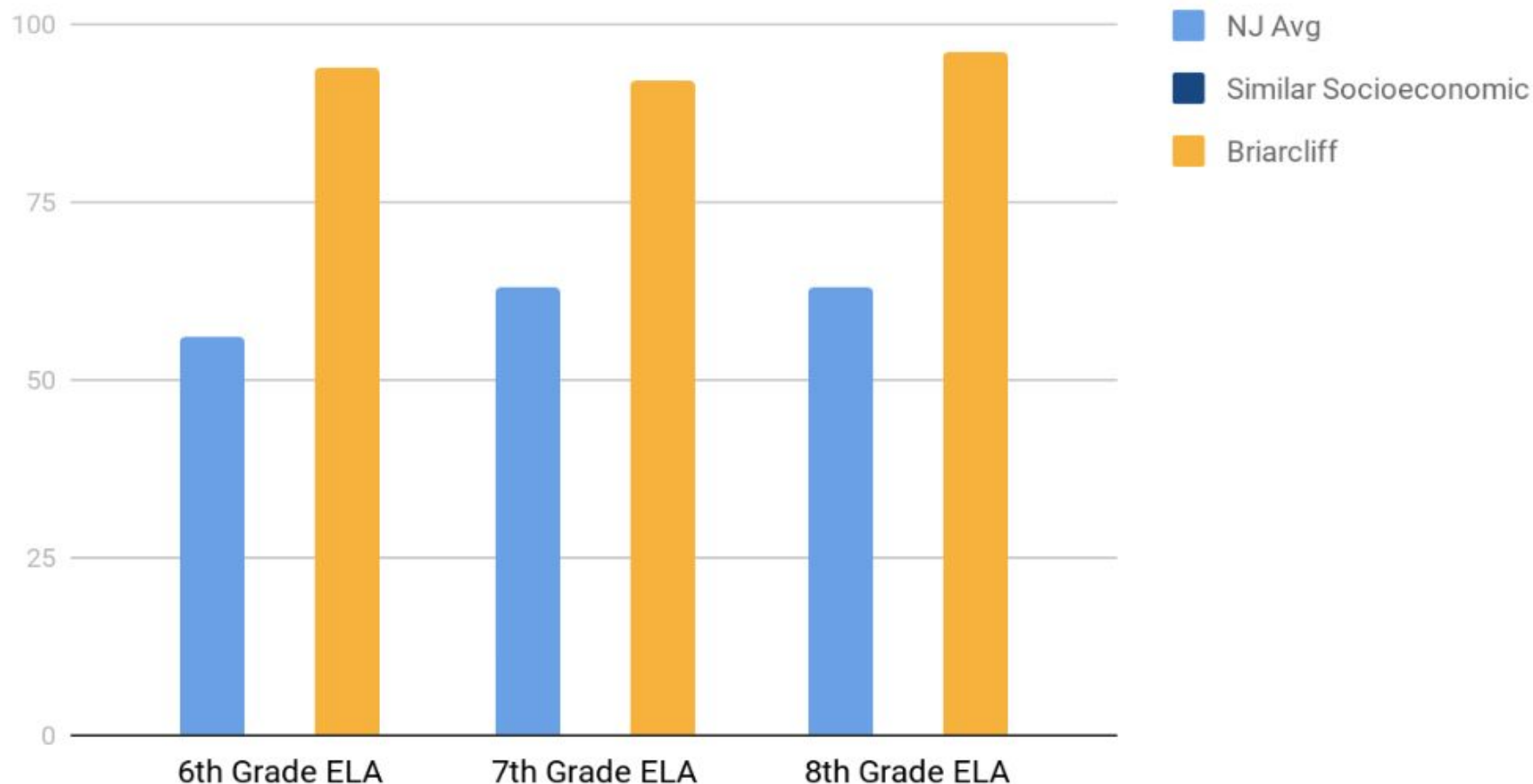


# Wildwood Comparing ELA PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019



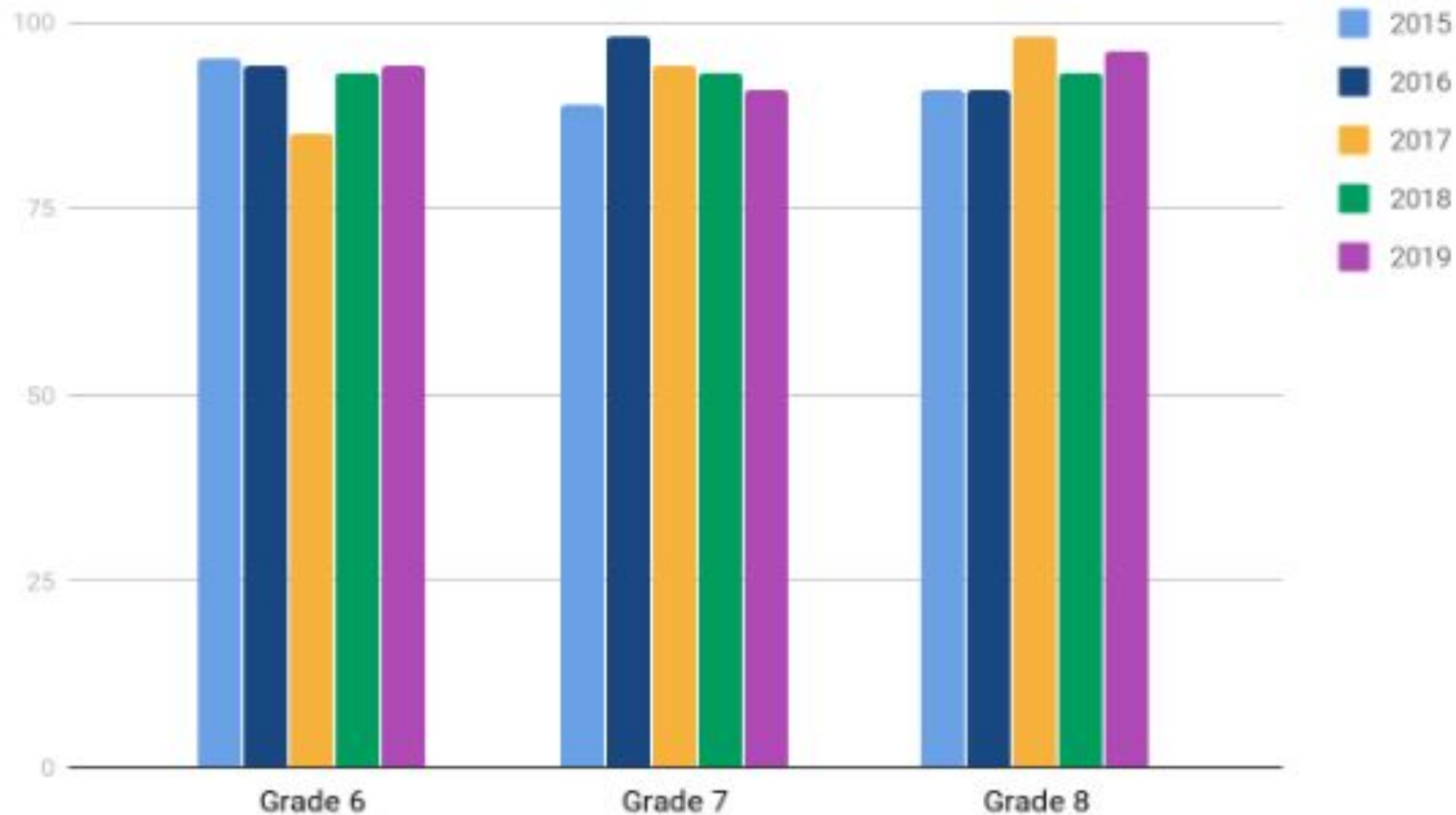

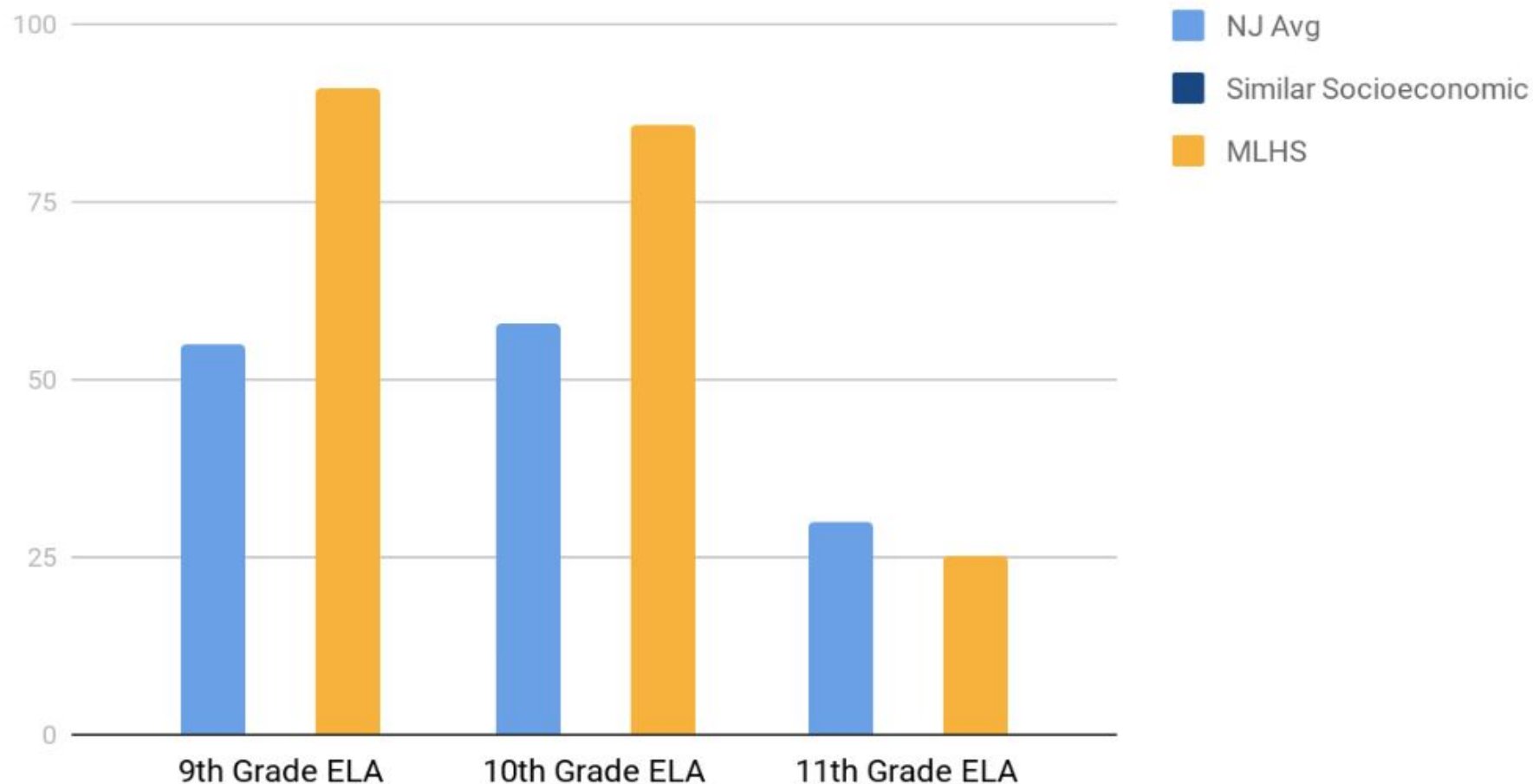


# Briarcliff Comparing ELA PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019



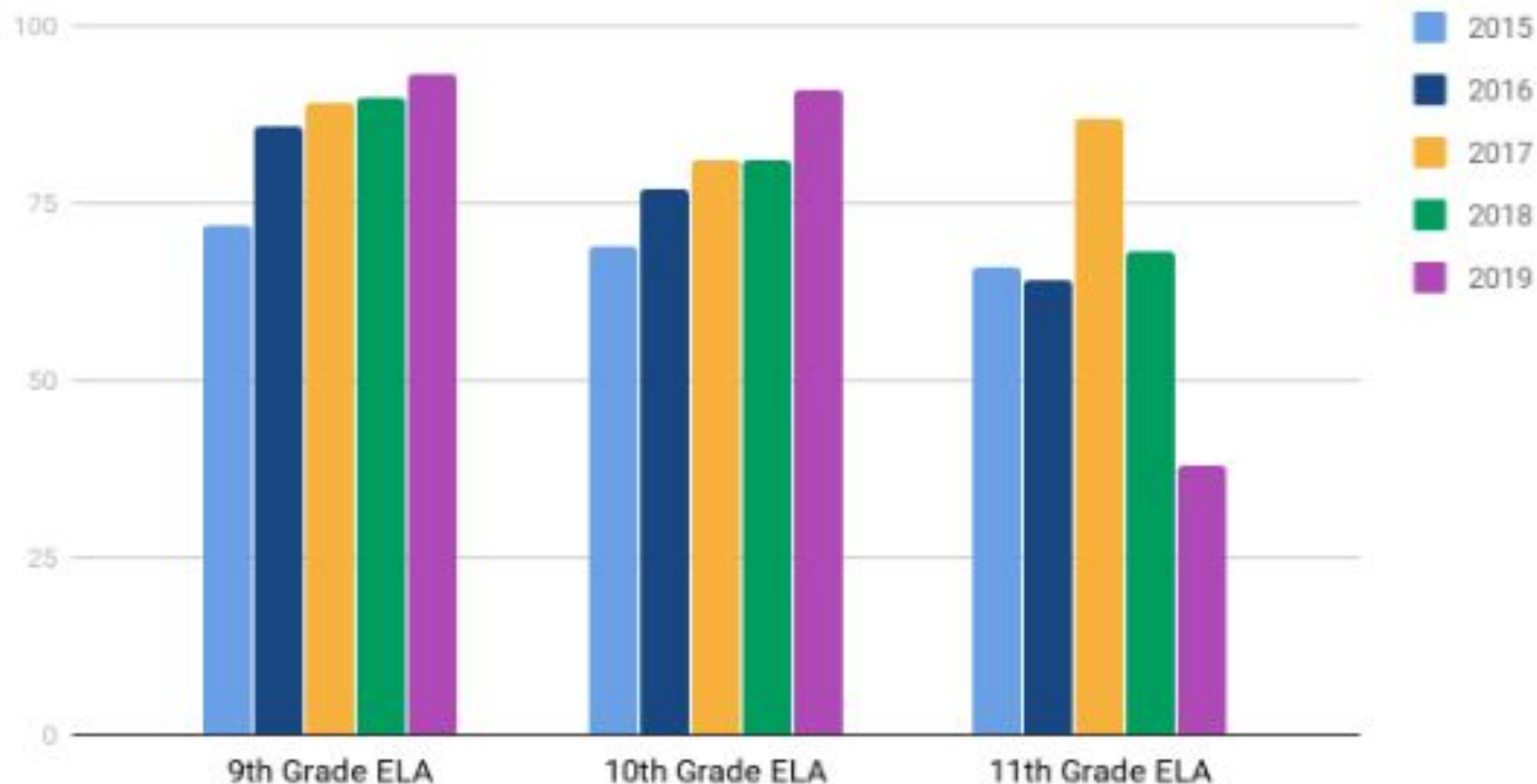
# MLHS: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 9<sup>TH</sup>-11<sup>TH</sup> GRADE ELA 2019

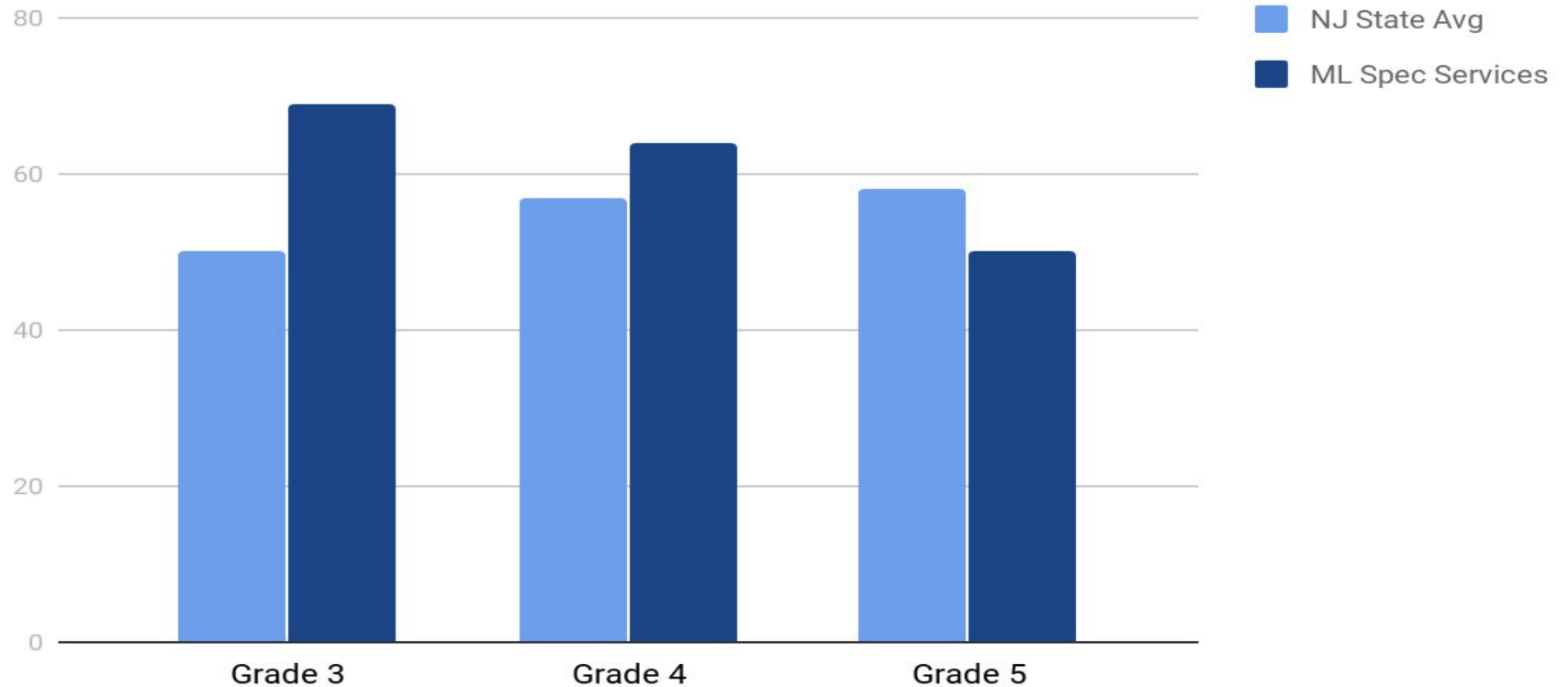

Points scored

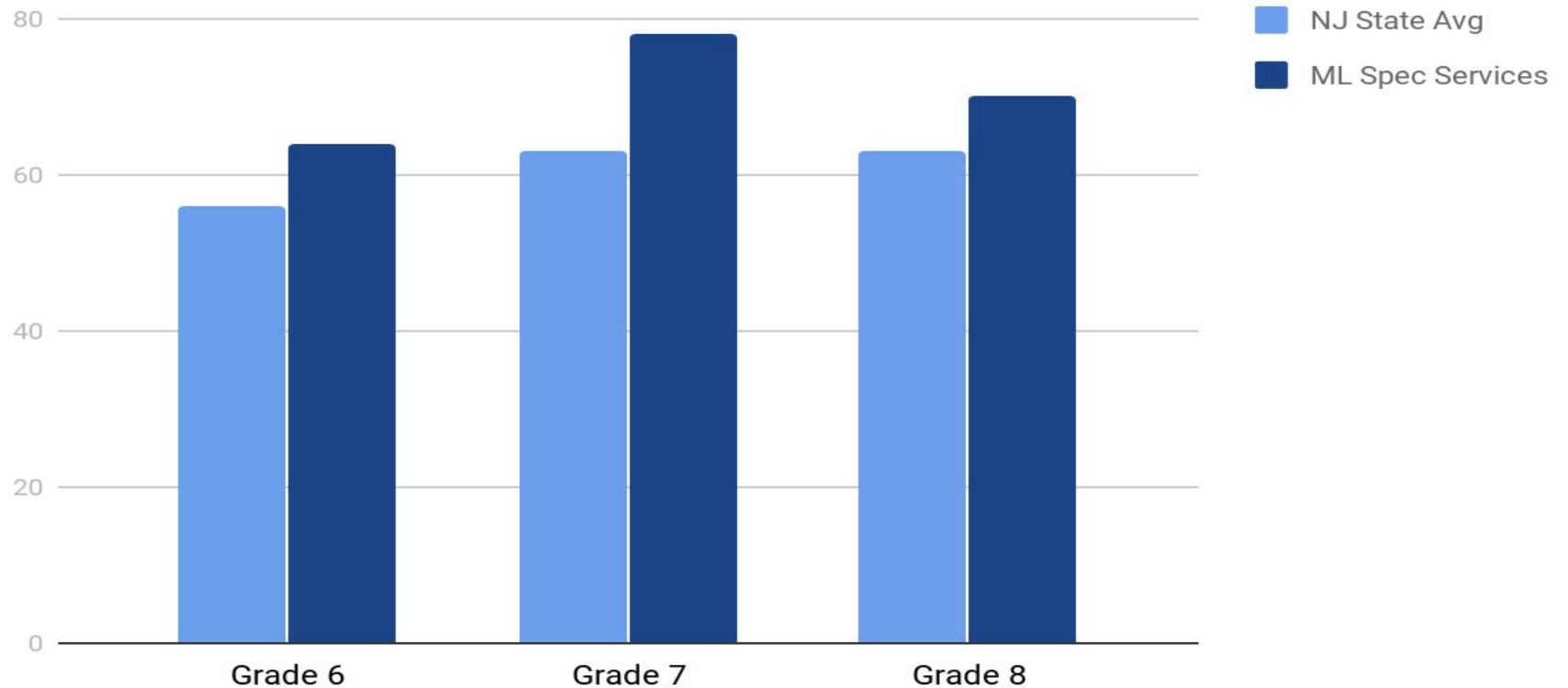

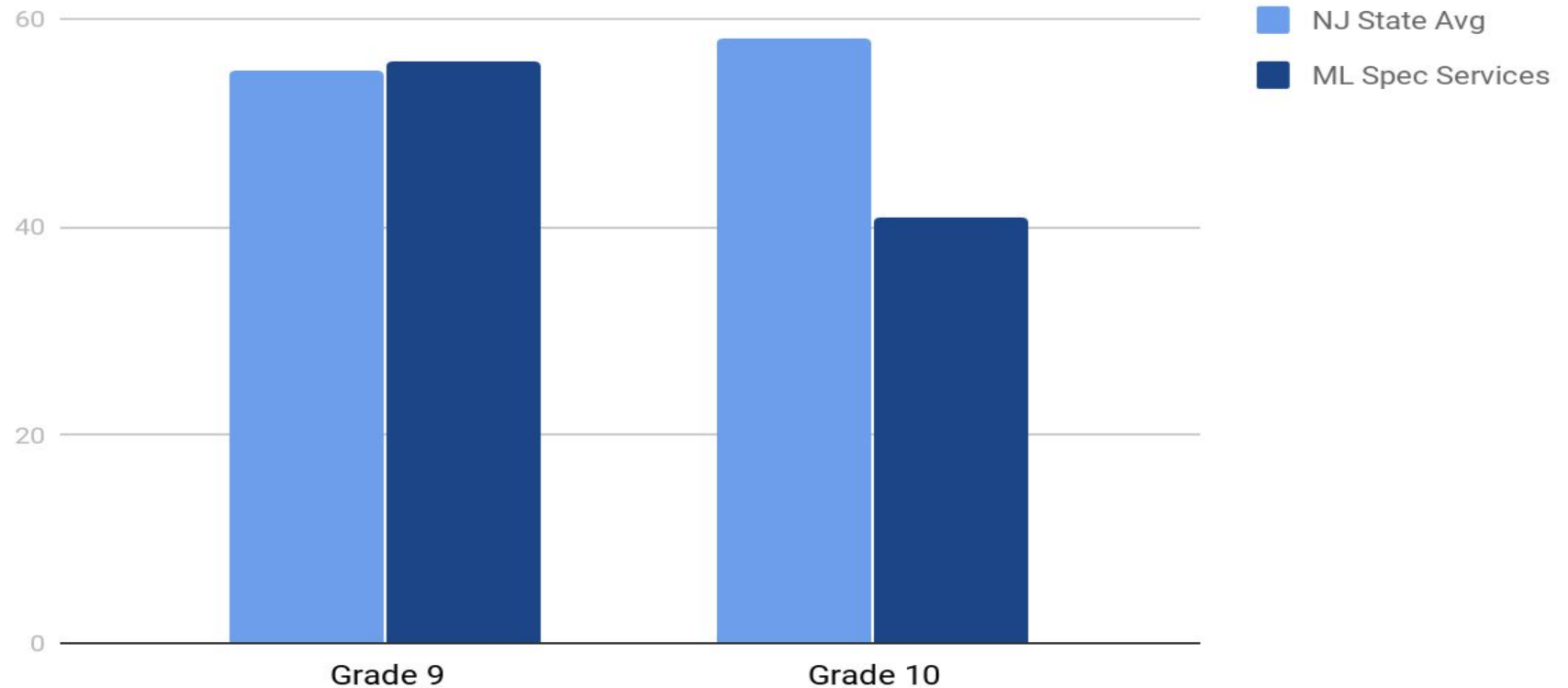

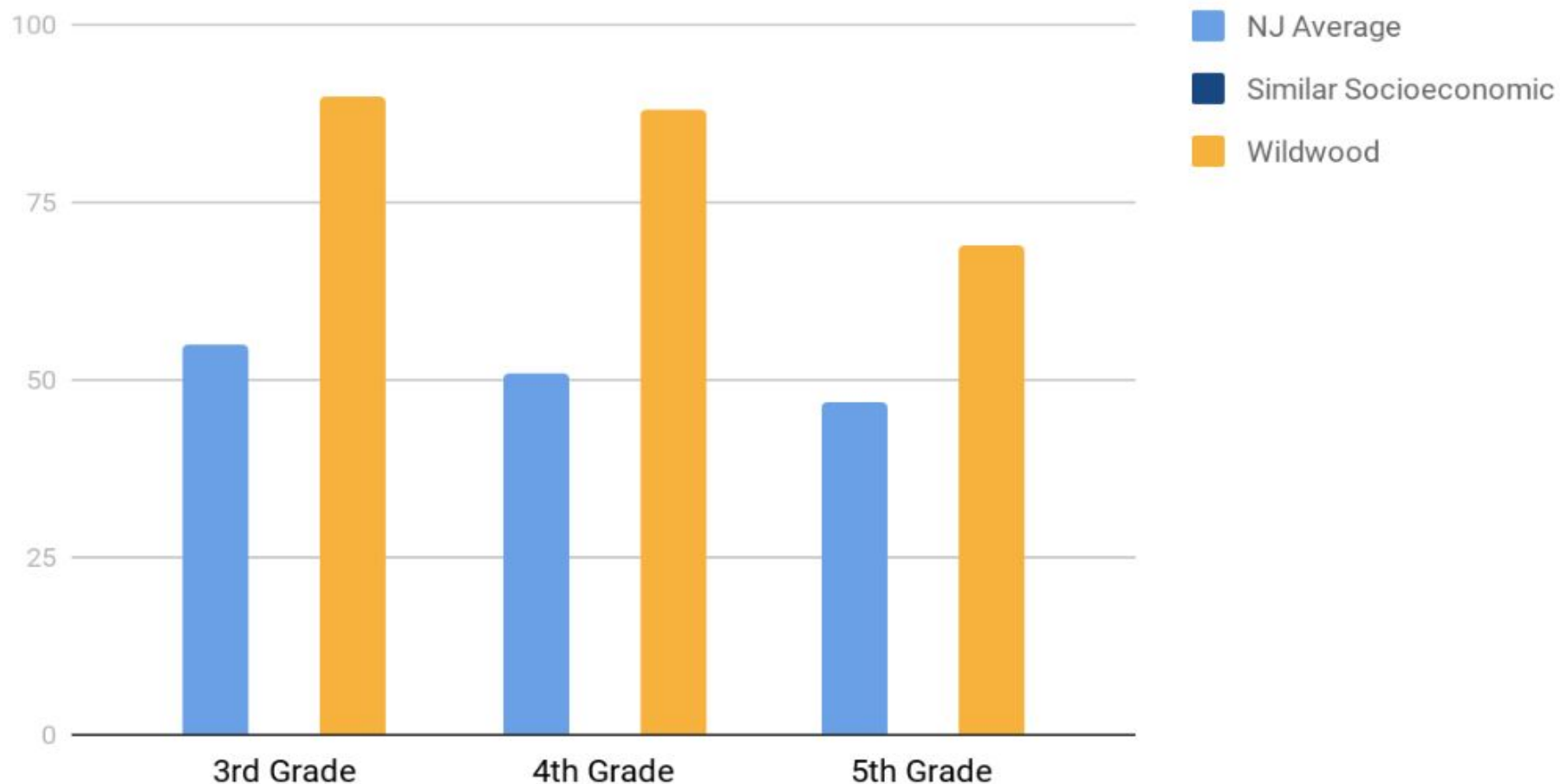

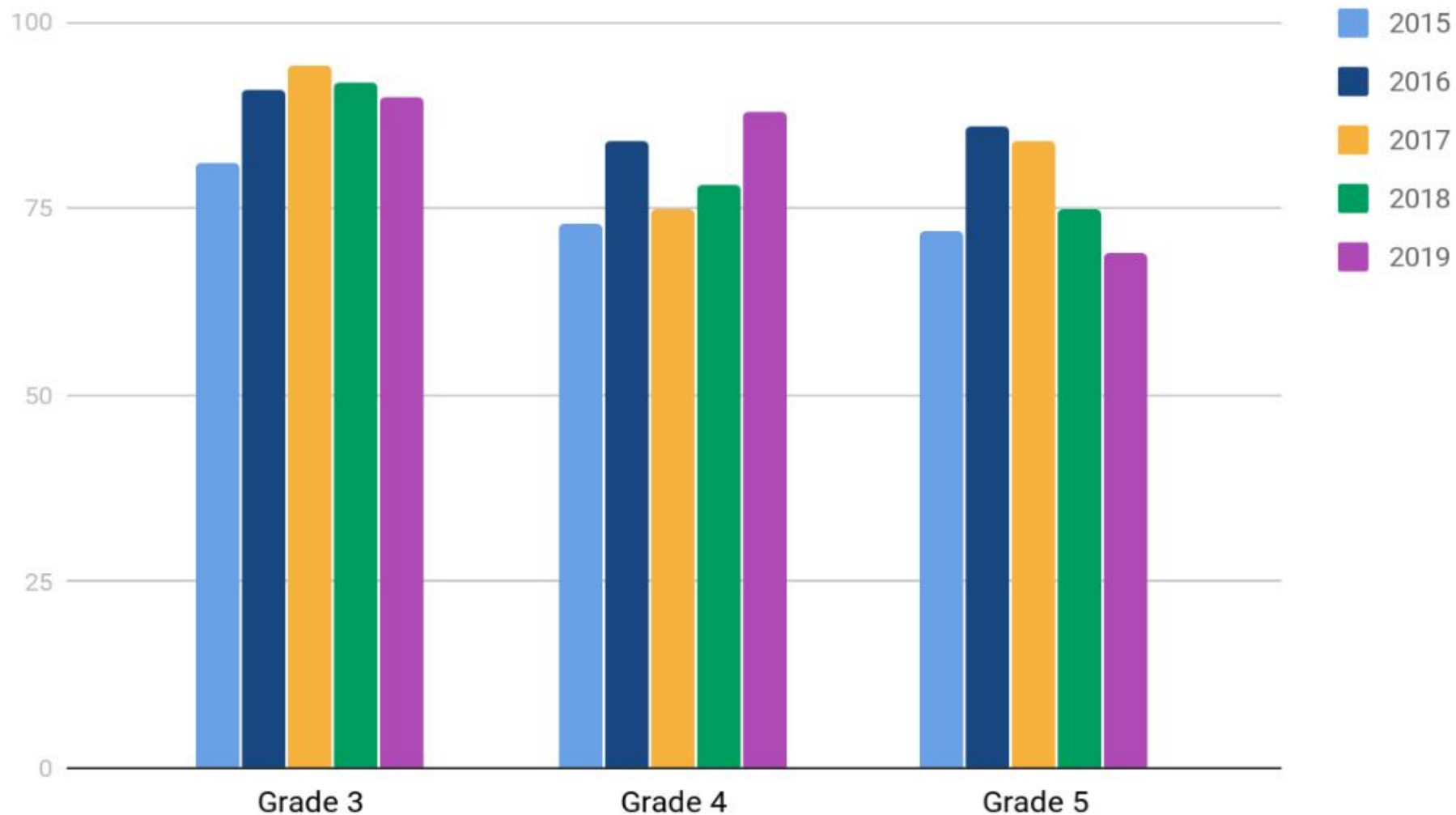

% Passing Math

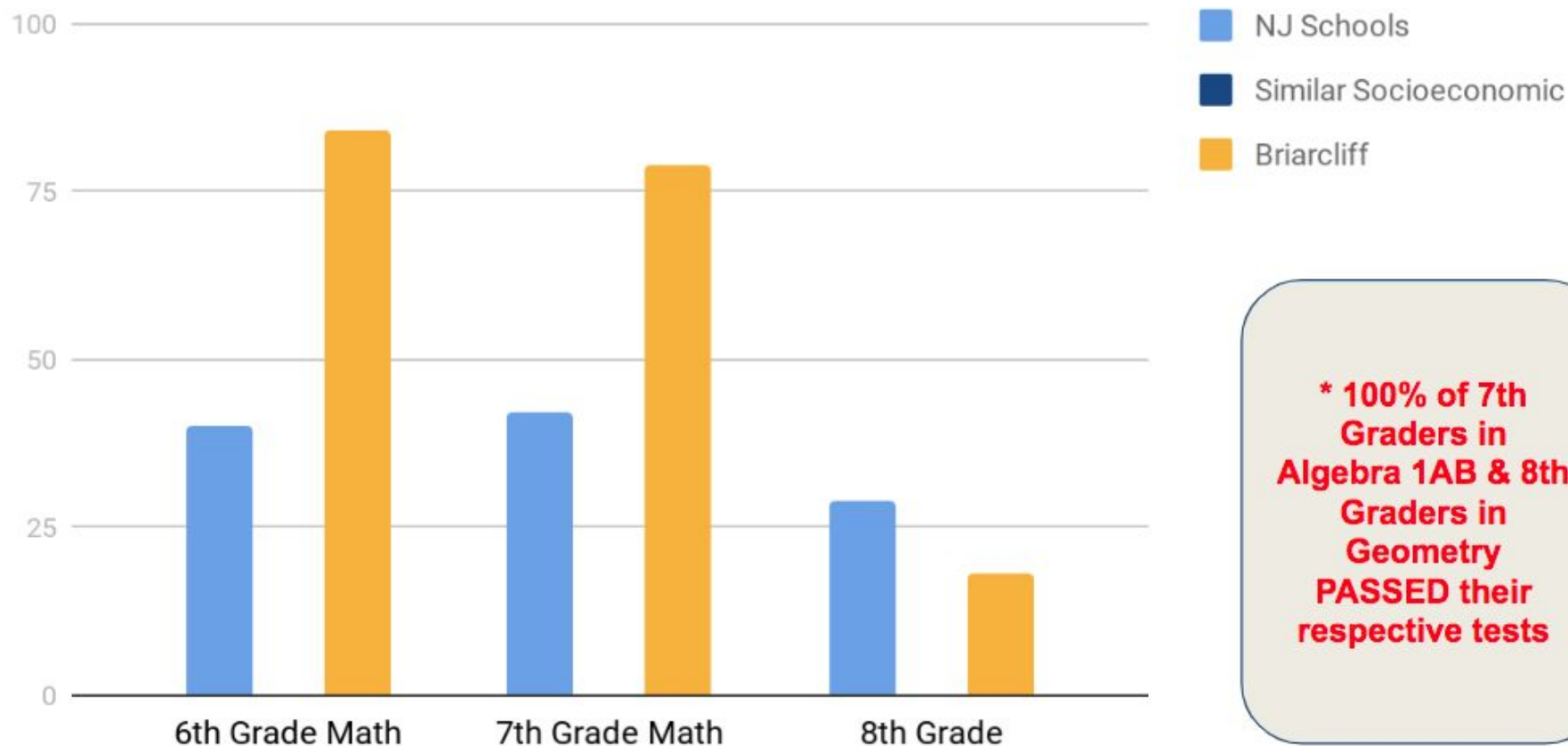


# Wildwood Comparing MATH PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019

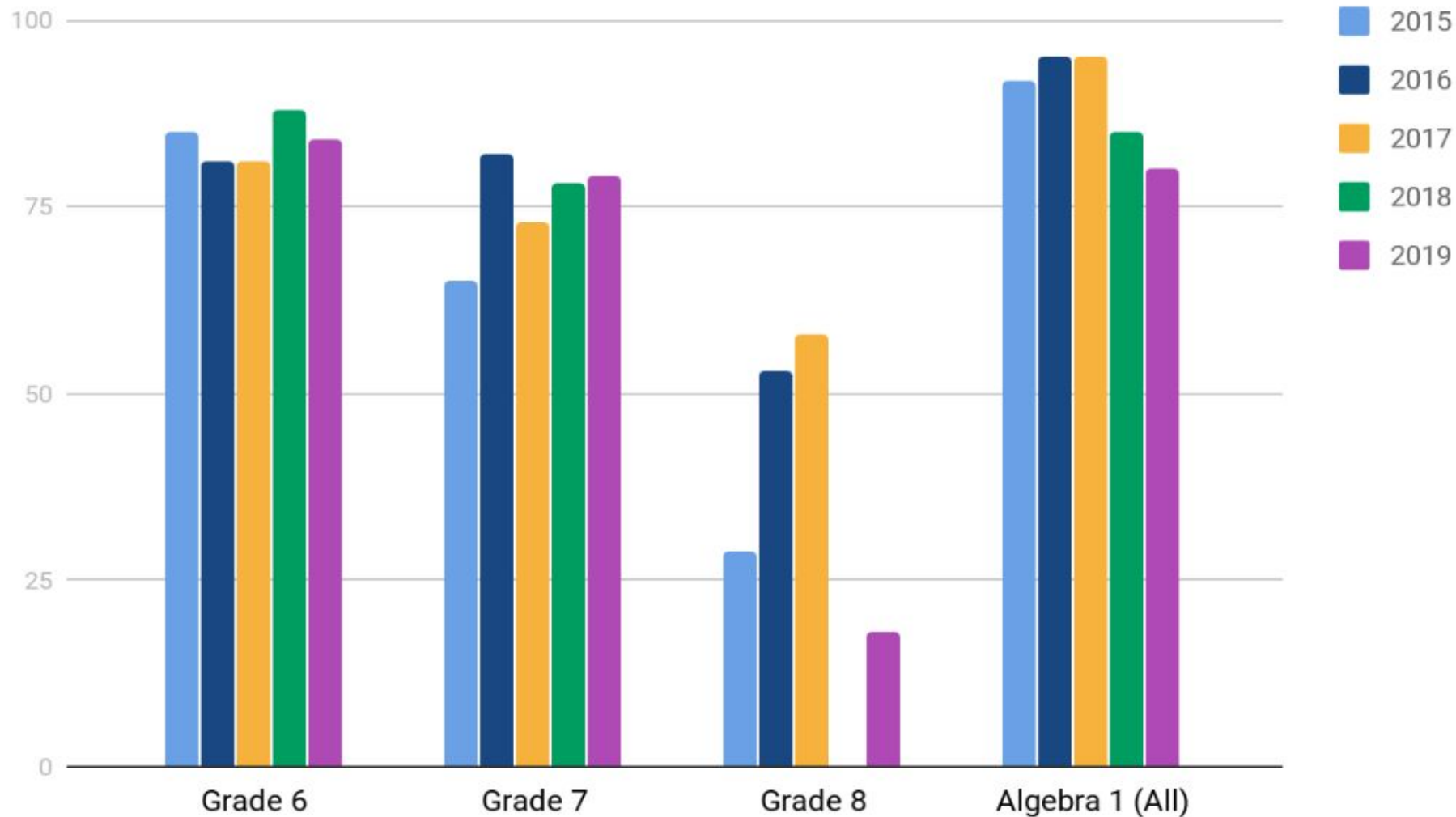


# BRIARCLIFF: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 6<sup>TH</sup>-8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE MATH\*

7th & 8th Graders taking Algebra & Geometry are NOT part of this data. See next slide

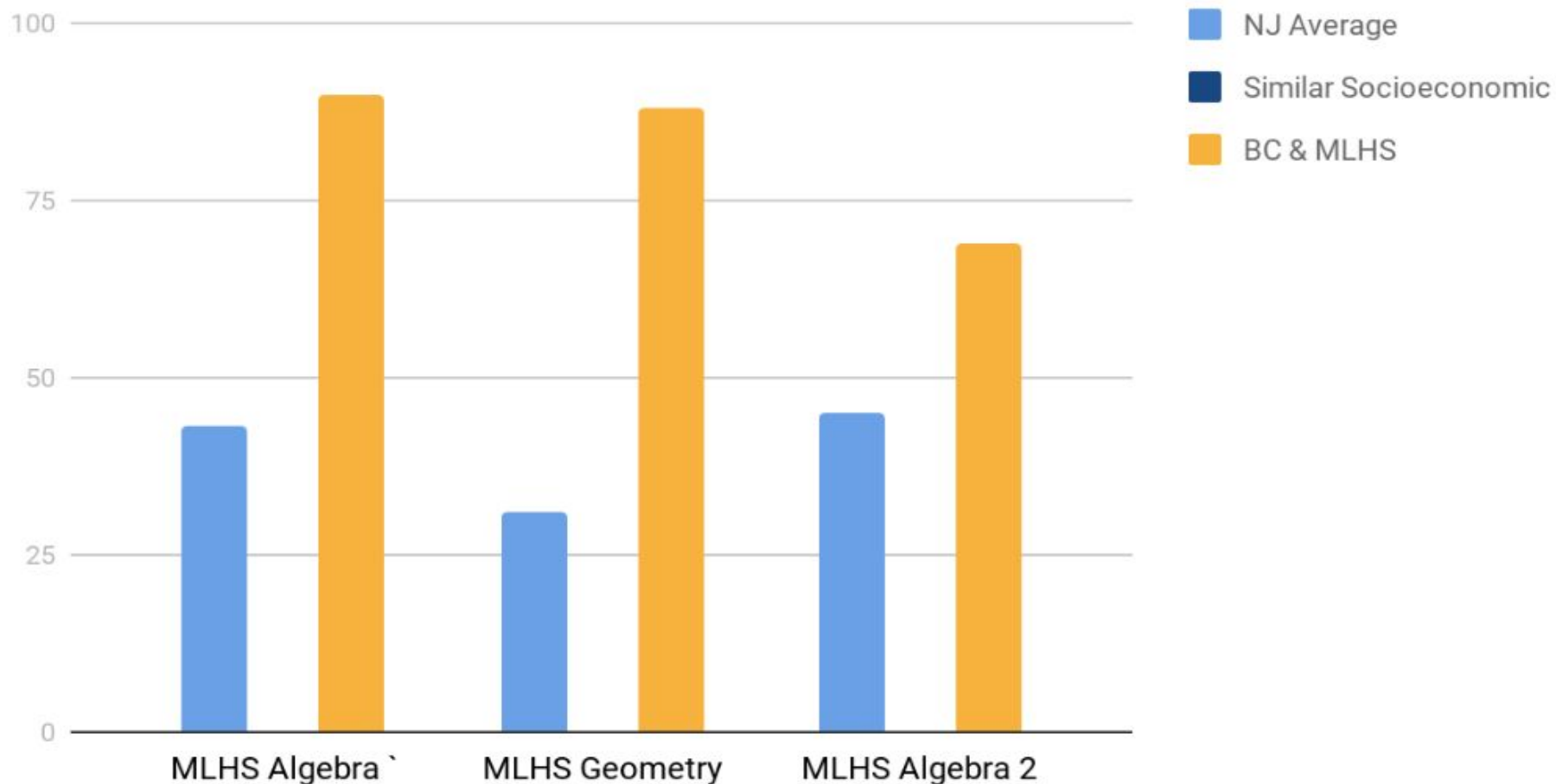


# Briarcliff Comparing MATH PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019

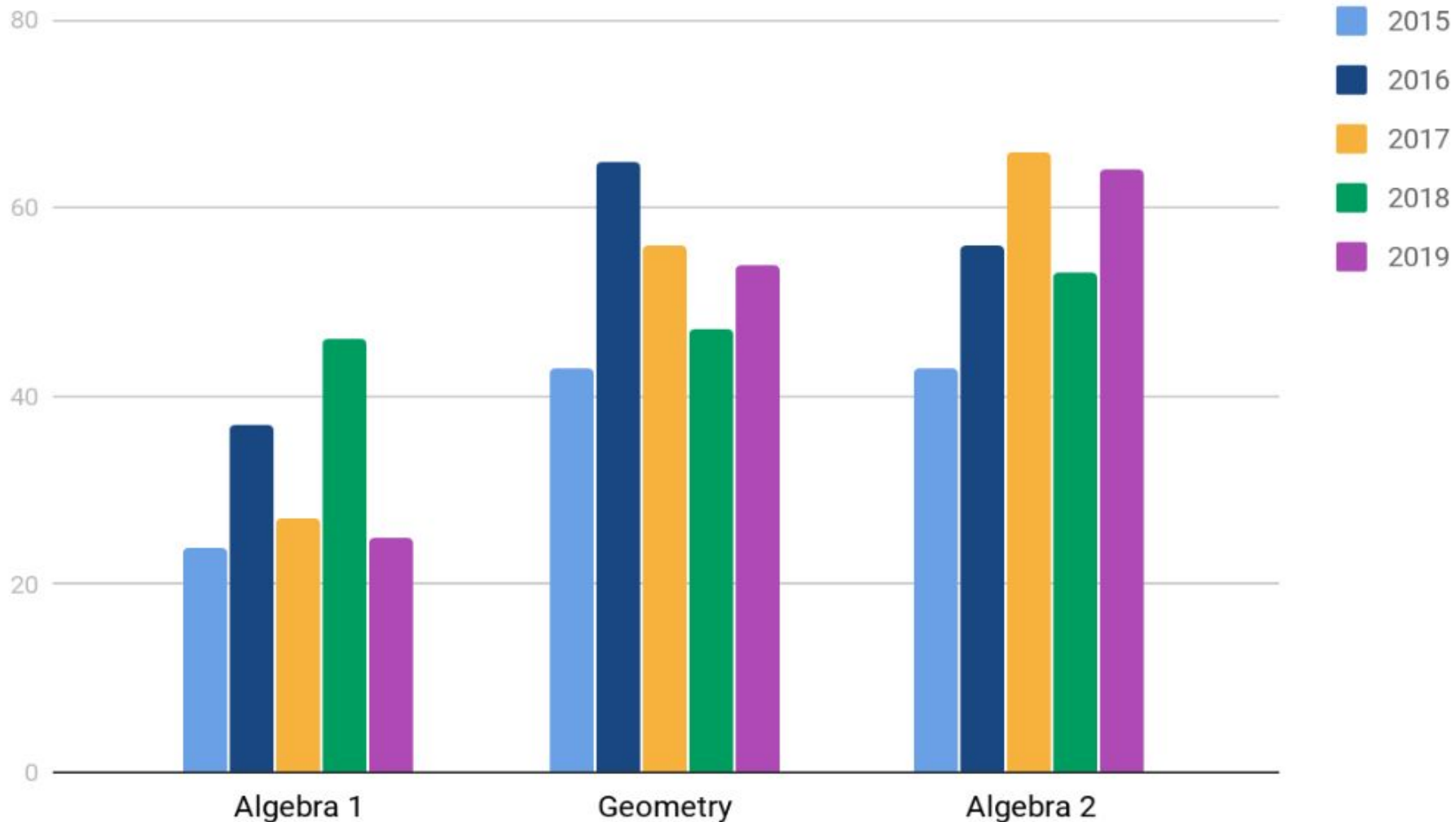


# MLHS: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR “High School” MATH 2019

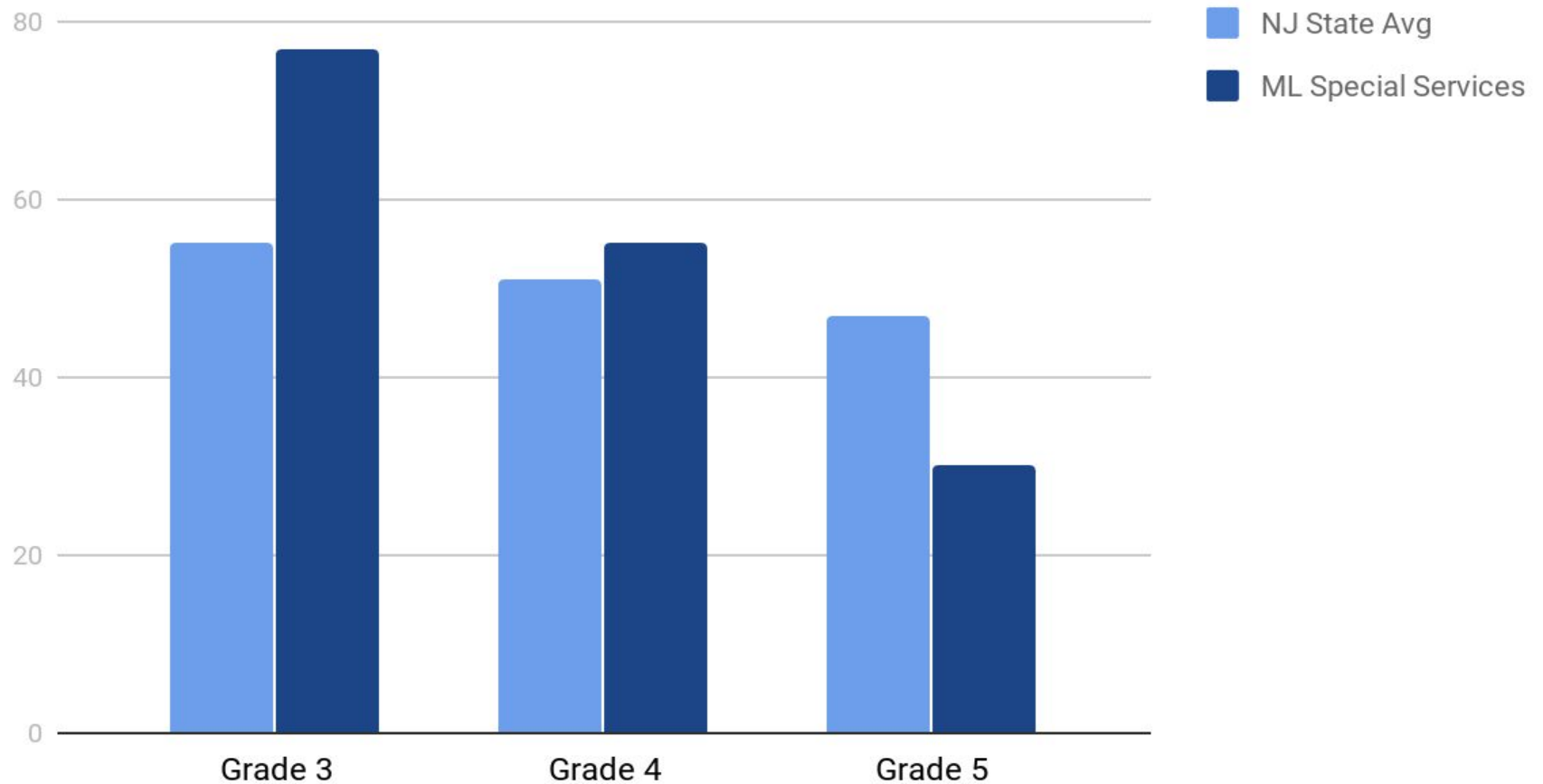

Points scored

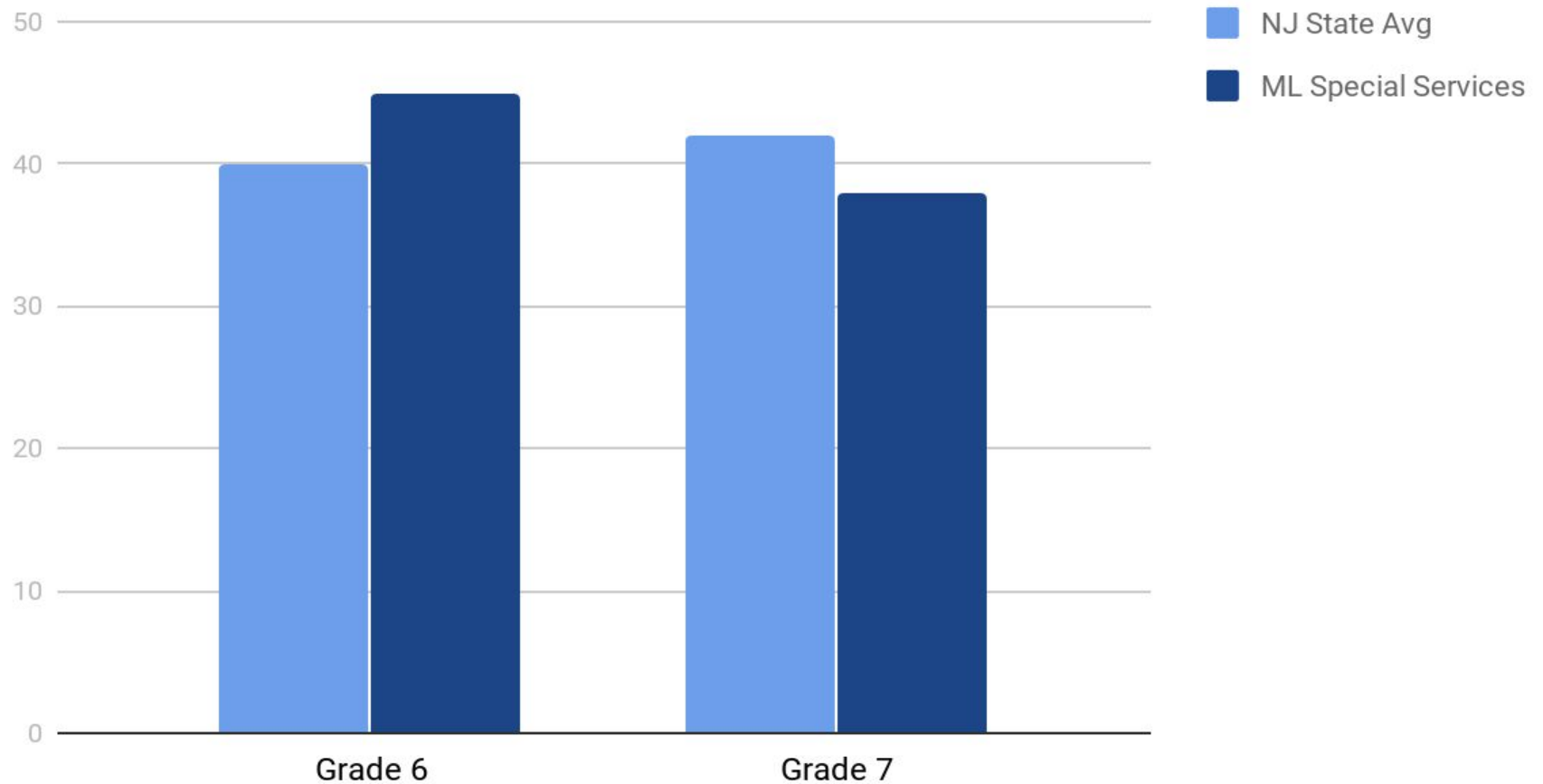

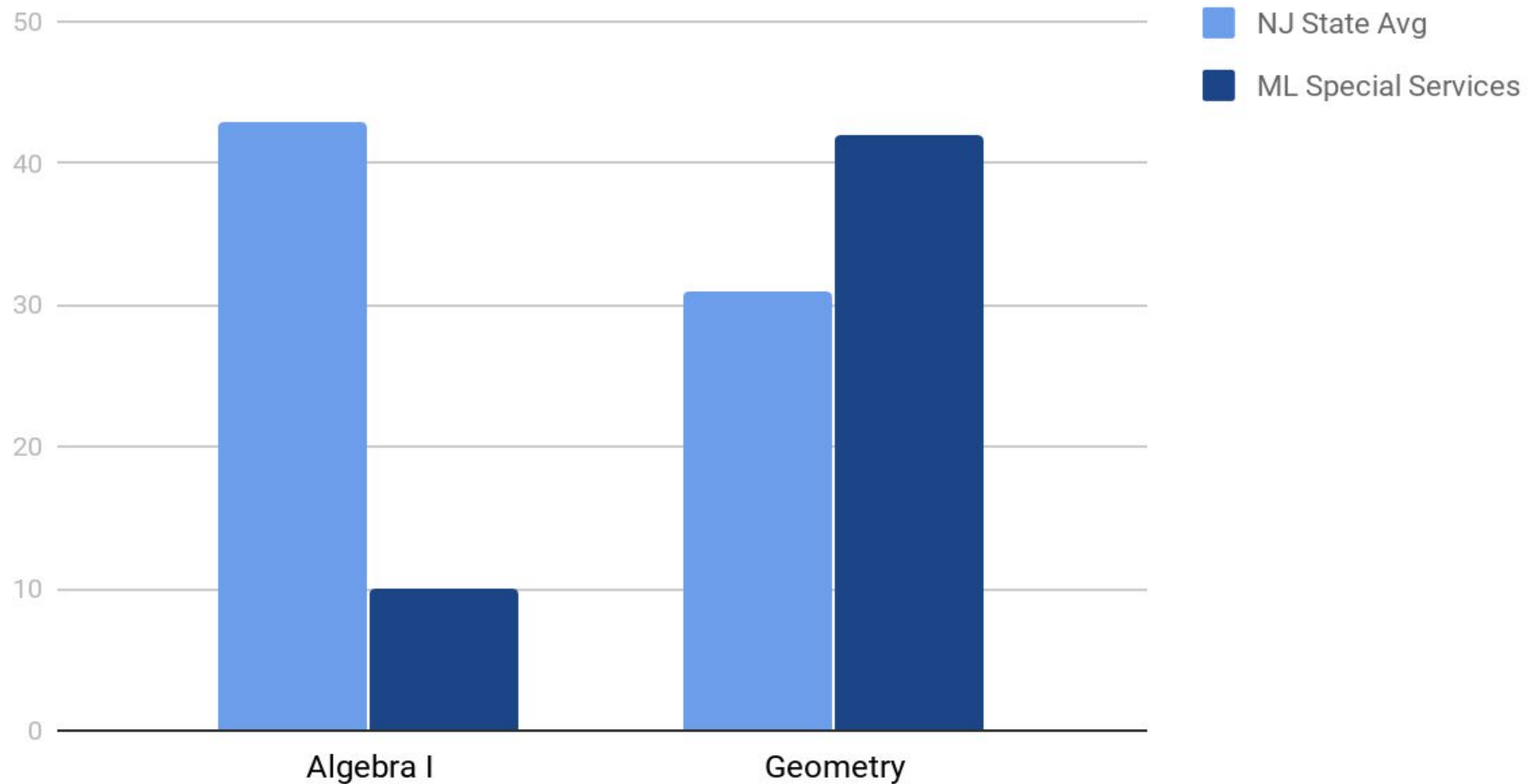

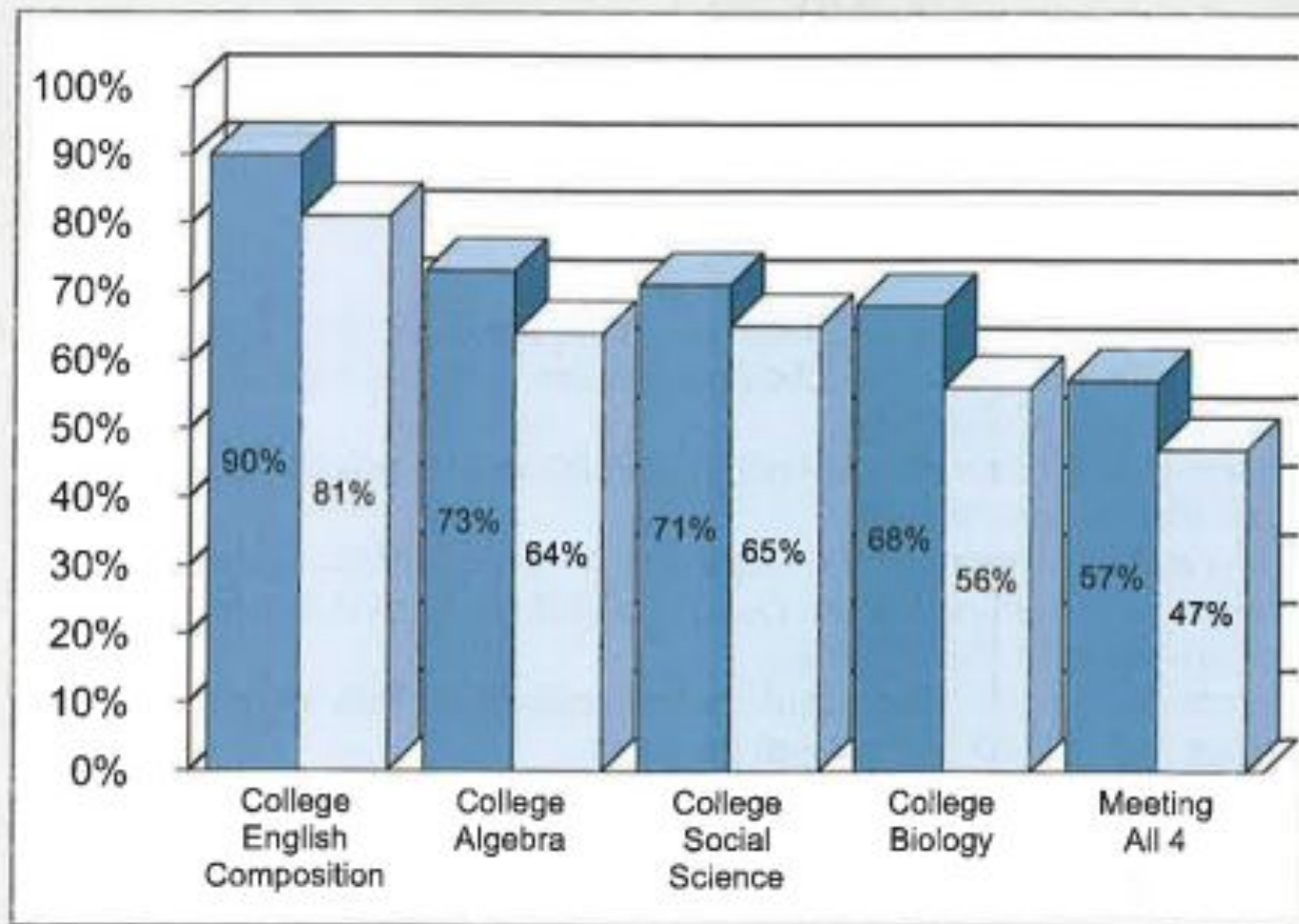

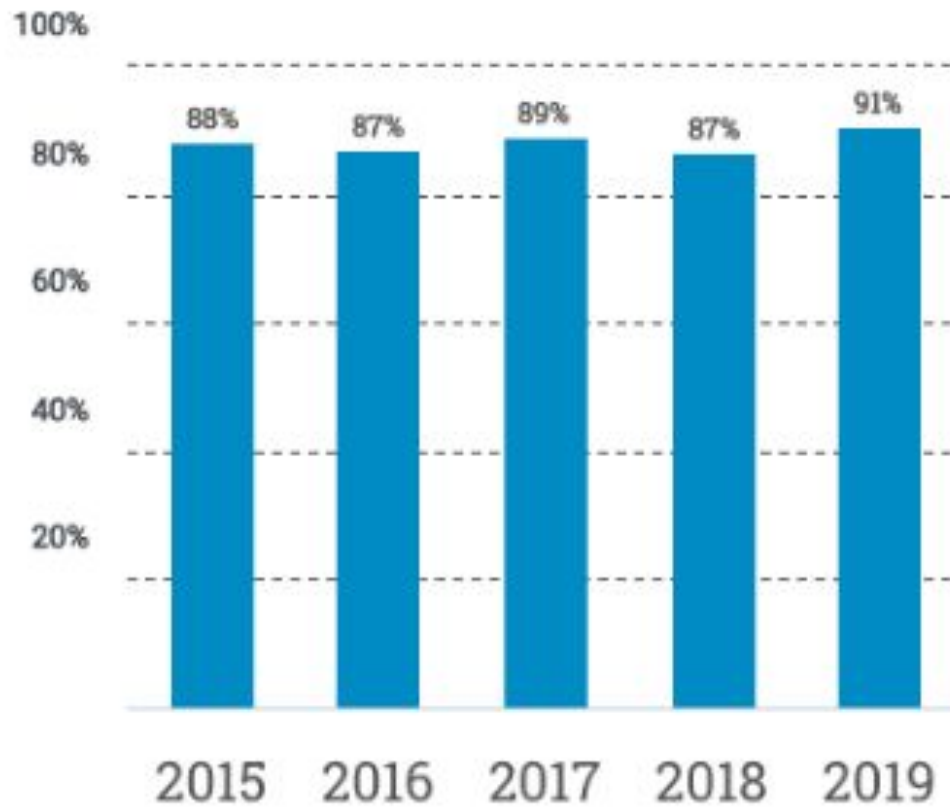

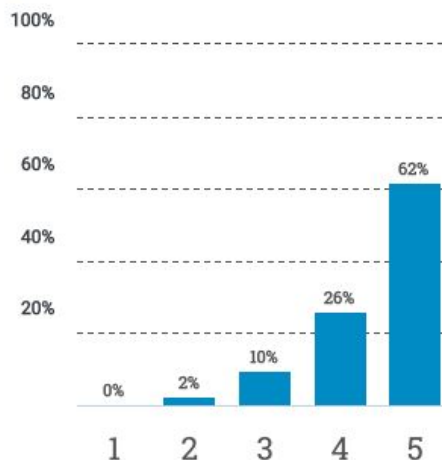
