
NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- 2019 marked the 1st administration of the NJ-SLA test which replaced the PARCC assessment. Although new, it was still produced by Pearson and therefore continued to give us another opportunity to compare year-to-year results as the following slides will show.
- Students were required to take NJ-SLA English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 10 (11th grade was optional)
- Students took NJ-SLA Mathematics Assessments in grades 3

 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I, Geometry,
 and Algebra II. Juniors were exempt as well last year.








WILDWOOD: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 3RD-5TH GRADE ELA 2019







Wildwood Comparing ELA PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019




BRIARCLIFF: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 6TH-8TH GRADE ELA 2019

MLHS: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 9TH-11TH GRADE ELA 2019









% Passing Math




Wildwood Comparing MATH PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019




BRIARCLIFF: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR 6TH-8TH GRADE MATH*

7th & 8th Graders taking Algebra & Geometry are NOT part of this data. See next slide




Briarcliff Comparing MATH PASSING Rates 2015 - 2019




MLHS: COMPARING PASSING RATES FOR "High School" MATH 2019



- 23 on Science


