Berne's Voices in Schools

- Parent voice STOPS behavior. Adult voice CHANGES behavior
- Many adults don't have an adult voice. (80% of discipline referrals come from 11% of the staff)
- Children have a low tolerance for teachers who use a child voice
- Change requires questions

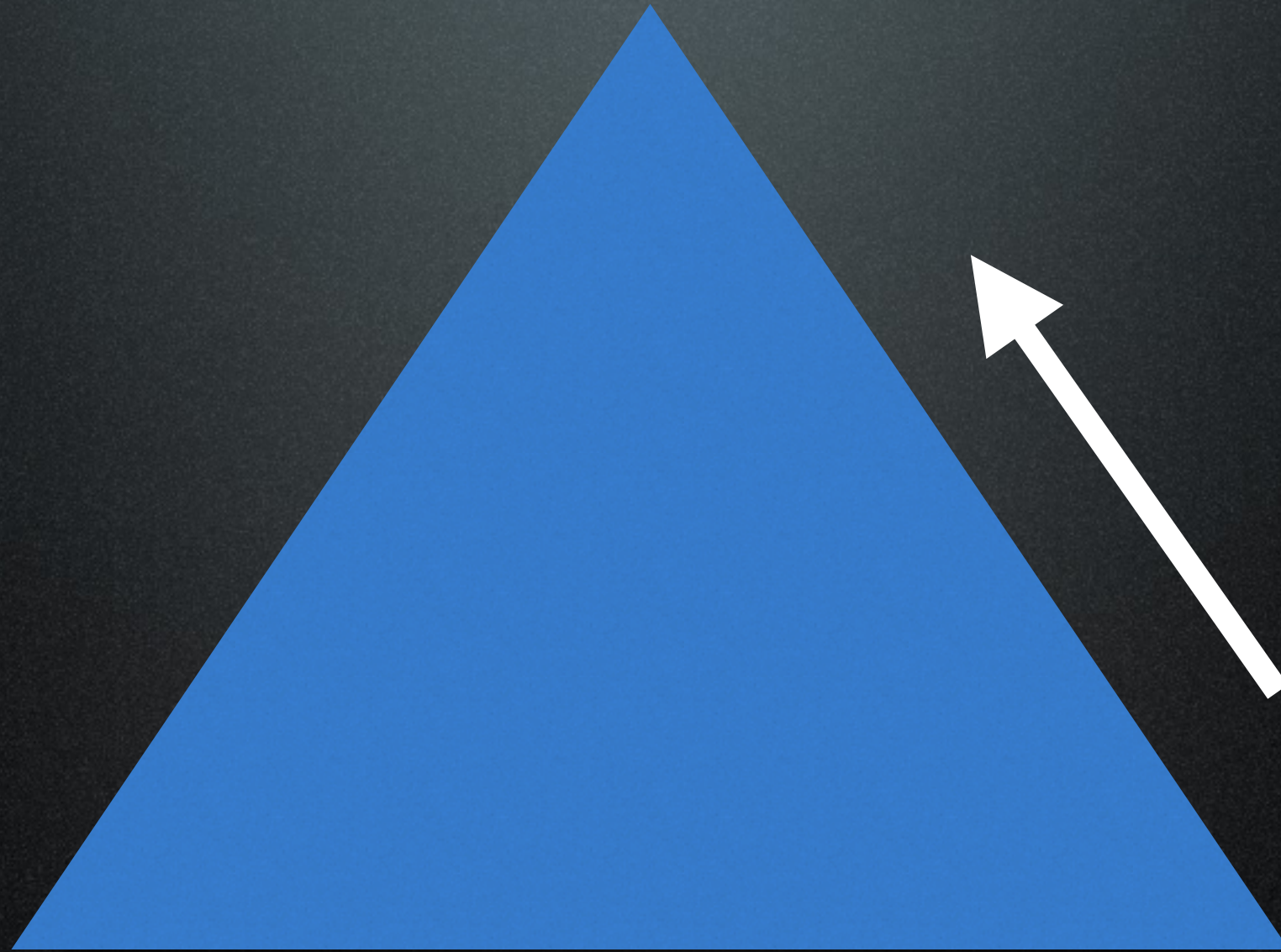

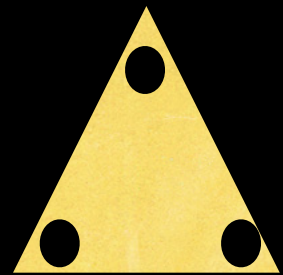
